In the second stage, the management of risk through the use of a reserve for the most risky projects. The proposed method in an article management contingency plan of the project lies in the fact that options have been turned out at the stage of longterm plan, supplemented by possible deviations from the programmed trajectory in view of the financial risk of the fund.

The used methods and avenues of analysis, adapted to the peculiarities of subsidized agricultural enterprises. The authors propose a way out subsidized farmers to self-financing.

The analysis showed that in the presence of losses the company has the ability to increase revenue and profit. The decrease in the loss ratio of sales indicates the relative cost savings with tendency achieve profitable operation. Reduce the difference between the actual and break-even sales volume leads to a break-even production.

The operating lever allows to achieve a profitable operation by increasing sales by more than 29,28%.

After evaluation of the EGF, the company has a negative FID, and therefore, will not be worth the financial cost of borrowing. But the increase in sales over the critical level will make the production of capable to pay back the loans. For this purpose, is entirely justified grants. The magnitude of the FIU reflects the existence of property guarantees loan repayment.

5.9. THE INFLUENCE OF NOMINAL ANCHOR CHOICE ON GDP DYNAMICS

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This paper examines the longterm effects of nominal anchor choice (monetary, inflation or exchange rate targeting) on output growth dynamics. Using panel data analysis of 189 countries during the 1999-2014 the authors find negative and significant effects of exchange rate targeting on output growth in both emerging and developed economies, while there is no evidence of negative effect on *GDP* growth in developing counties that moved to inflation targeting, inflation targeting may influence positively the *GDP* growth in developed countries.

Over last ten years the interest for financial statements where assets, liabilities, shareholders' equity, incomes and expenses are reported at fair value increased noticeably. Moreover, companies' managers are sure that reporting financial liabilities at fair value can lead to the decrease in the cost of equity. However, the existing researches of the relationship between fair value accounting of financial liabilities and cost of equity demonstrate contradictory results. In this article the regression model was used to investigate this relationship for Russian companies. The results obtained illustrate that the volatility of liabilities reported at fair value influences the cost of equity. It confirms the hypotheses that changes in fair value of financial liabilities can be used by investors as the indicator of company's credit risk.
